Blackbourn Trophy/Caithness Bowl Summary Rules

- The **Blackbourn Trophy** is awarded to the winning panel of 5-9 prints from a member in the **Advanced** print class. Certificates are awarded to the winner and 2 runners-up.
- The **Caithness Bowl** is awarded to the winning panel of 5-9 prints from a member in the **Standard or Intermediate** print class combined. Certificates are awarded to the winner and 2 runners-up.
- Panels: A member may submit up to two panels on themes of their choosing.
- Eligibility: No panel may have been used in earlier PDI or print panel competitions.
- Individual images that have been used in earlier Print or PDI *competitions* can be used as part of a panel.
- Total Panel Size: Each panel must fit on one BPS Display Board (1200 mm x 1800 mm).
- **Mount Size:** Prints should be mounted, and mounts can be *any suitable size*. Some or all the panel's prints may be on the same mount. Mounts <u>do not have to be</u> the 40 cm x 50 cm used for other print competitions.
- **Print Size:** Prints may be any suitable size.
- **Title:** The title of each panel must be displayed.
- **Registration:** The panel images should be uploaded in the usual way by 11:45 pm on the Sunday before the competition. Upload each panel separately.
- Hanging: Participants are expected to arrive at about 7.30 pm on the competition evening to
 help with carrying and setting up the club's display panels and hanging their own work. Velcro
 clips are provided. Participants are also expected to help taking down the display panels and
 putting them away.
